

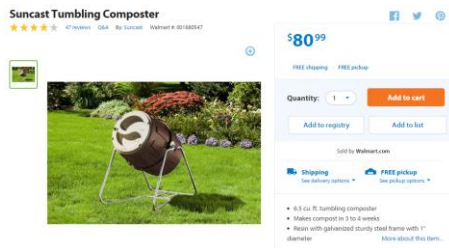


10 Steps for Successful Outdoor Vermicomposting

10. Getting the best out of your compost

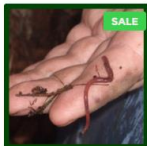

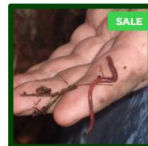

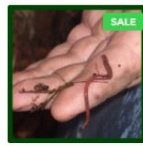
